with these characters.

New 3-D animation gives the "Peanuts" characters a fresh visual boost that enables the film and charac-

ters to seem more modern without losing one bit of the gentle and heartfelt emotions generated by Charles M. Schulz when he was creating his comic strips.

However, with its references to the first walk on the moon in 1969, Snoopy's use of a typewriter and the absence of any modern devices, such as cellphones, the film also has a bit of a retro feel.

It doesn't seem dated, though, because of the focus on Charles M. Schulz's

timeless observations on childhood.

For longtime fans of Charlie Brown who want to relive their cherished childhood memories of the "Peanuts" gang or who want to share them with their children or grandchildren, "The Peanuts Movie" is the perfect opportunity to discover an old friend in a shiny new 21st-century presentation that will still feel like home.
