Independent record stores offer special buys Friday

Record collectors will have a new round of choices Friday during the year's second Record Store Day on Black Friday.

Though not as big an event as the main Record Store Day in April, the Black Friday sale will have many new items for record collectors to salivate over, including a 12-inch single vinyl reissue of Paul McCartney and Michael Jackson's duet "Say Say Say" and vinyl records of David Bowie's "Earthling" album and John Mellencamp's "Scarecrow" album.

Record Store Day was created to celebrate independently owned record stores around the United States and internationally, and the cultures surrounding them. Record stores that participate in Record Store Day also have limited-edition vinyl and CD releases for sale that are only available at participating stores.

Five local record stores will have a wide range of new and exclusive vinyl and CDs available to purchase this Friday. Here's a preview:

All three locations will be open 8 a.m.-8 p.m. on Black Friday Record Store Day.

Bob Roets, Wooden Nickel owner, says all three Wooden Nickel stores have a 10 percent off coupon good Friday and also Saturday, which is Small Business Saturday nationally.

Three prizes will be given away: a copy of the Beatles' "1+" Blu-ray set, an Audio Technica AT-LP 60 Turntable and a \$200 Wooden Nickel gift certificate.

Rick "Doc" West from local radio station WXKE, 96.3-FM, will broadcast live from the North Anthony store and bring doughnuts.

Roets says he's gotten a lot of requests for the Stevie Ray Vaughan two-LP set ("A Legend in the Making"), a Janis Joplin two-LP set ("Live at Winterland 68"), and Nine Inch Nails and Judas Priest vinyl releases.

"My favorite thing about Record Store Day is seeing young people come in and buy vinyl from my era," Roets said.

Entourage Music owner Chris Roets said highlights Friday include anniversary reissues that haven't been out on vinyl before or which haven't been available for a long time. Soundtracks such as "High Fidelity" and "Garden State," as well as Judas Priest's sawblade die-cut record, "Painkiller 25th Anniversary," are just a few of the things that Roets feels will stand out.
